



make your own Butterfly feeder

you will need:

- Jam jar
 - String
 - Sponge
-

1. Make a small hole in the center of the jar's lid and poke a small bit of sponge half-way through to soak up the nectar - not too big or the sponge will fall out.

2. Tie a string around the jar, so that it can hang upside-down with the lid facing the ground.

3. fill jar with nectar and hang in the garden. Decorate, and remember butterflies love red!

Butterfly nectar recipe

Combine nine parts water and one part sugar, heating the mixture until the sugar dissolves. Once it has cooled, half fill your feeder!
