
These events require a ticket to be purchased in advance or at the box office on the day. £7.50 full price (£5.50 concessions - available for students, Under 18s and Groups of 10+).


### Ticketed (Free)



# WELCOME TO SUMMER IN THE SCENE DOCK!

Our scene dock is the space behind our theatre where trucks come to unload sets, costumes, lighting, and sound equipment.

Over the summer, we're thrilled to be welcoming the hit musical *Hamilton* to our stage for six weeks. Without the usual comings and goings of regular touring shows, the dock will be unusually quiet. That got us thinking: what if we used this space in a completely different way?

We wanted to create something for the city, something for those who love our theatre but equally for those who may not have ever visited us before and are curious to try something new. What if we could celebrate bringing people together through creativity and fun in the sun?

So, ***Summer in the Scene Dock*** was born.

It is an outdoor theatre space that expands the perimeter of TRP for the people of Plymouth and those visiting. We have a variety of fantastic events ranging from quizzes to workshops, from theatre shows to poetry and dance performances, with every evening ending with a DJ set or live music to carry you into the night.

The festival has been created by TRP in collaboration with artists Kyla Goodey and Amy Pitt from Trifle Gathering Productions (*Beautiful Days, Lamar Tree Festival*) and our creative community connector and Plymouth-based artist, Azza Gasim.

We want the festival to be as easy to access as possible. Sometimes you'll need a ticket, other times you're invited to wander straight in. Whether you want to come and enjoy a drink in the sun, a snack on your lunch break or some joyful entertainment, there is something for everyone.

We invite you to show up as you are, all are welcome.
